I. REASSIGNMENT OF HEADQUARTERS, SPAIN AIR MATERIEL AREA.

1. Announcement is made of the reassignment of the Spain Air Materiel Area with Headquarters at Madrid, Spain, from Air Materiel Command to Air Materiel Force, European Area, effective 1 March 1956.

2. A report of the above action will be forwarded to the Commander, Air Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, Attention: MCCSP by means of the Air Force Organization Status Change Report (RCS AF-01) in compliance with Air Force Regulation 20-49 and current instructions.

3. Authority: Air Force Regulation 20-27.

II. ASSUMPTION OF COMMAND JURISDICTION, CONTROL AND ACCOUNTABILITY.

1. Announcement is made that jurisdiction, control, and accountability over a portion of Westover Air Force Base, Chicopee Falls, Massachusetts, was transferred from Military Air Transport Service to Air Materiel Command and was designated Stony Brook Air Force Station, effective 1 November 1954.

2. Authority: Paragraph VI, Department of the Air Force General Order Number 3, 17 January 1956.

III. RELOCATION OF THE 3084TH AVIATION DEPOT GROUP. 1. Announcement is made of the relocation of the 3084th Aviation Depot Group from Westover Air Force Base, Massachusetts to Stony Brook Air Force Station, Chicopee Falls, Massachusetts, effective 1 November 1954, without change in assignment, personnel or equipment.

2. Authority: Paragraph 6, Department of the Air Force General Order Number 3, 17 January 1956.

IV. INACTIVATION OF THE 23RD CRASH RESCUE BOAT FLIGHT. 1. The 23rd Crash Rescue Boat Flight, Brookley Air Force Base, Alabama, is inactivated, effective 8 June 1956, and will revert to the control of the Department of the Air Force.
