1. General Situation: The Commander, 3084th ADG (AMG), directs a locally prepared and directed Type I and Type II walkthrough training operation for the period 9 - 13 January 1956.

- a. Enemy Forces: Omitted.
- b. Friendly Forces: Westover (S.C) Task Force.

(1) This Task Force will implement such responsibilities outlined in Tab #2 to Appendix 7 to Annex C, WTF OPLAN 44-56 dated 1 November 1955 as are necessary to support this exercise on X Plus 3.

2. Mission: The 3084th ADG (AMG) will conduct a training maneuver involving:

- a. Maximum individual training by all sections through utilization of walkthrough procedures.
- b. One MK 6 Mod 4/5 training weapon and three MK 6 Mod 6 training weapons for assembly from ready status to CAS configuration.
- c. Two MK 17 Mod 1 training weapons for assembly from stockpile to CAS configuration.
- d. Training in procedures of dispersal, convoy to WCP, transfer of weapons and components, Weapons Control Point Operation, convoy to Q Area and storage.

3. Tasks for Subordinate Units:

- a. 3084th Inspection Section.

- (1) Between 1300Z and 2200Z on X plus 3 supply one officer to fulfill the requirements of AMC WCP Control Officer. This officer will coordinate with the Senior SAC Control Officer on the procedures of a typical joint SAC-AMC operation.
- (2) Weapon and component delivery requests will be coordinated through the AMC Control Center Controller who will be present at the WCP.

b. 3084th Operations Squadron.

(1) Assembly Division I.

- (a) Between 1300Z and 2200Z on X day, X plus 1 and X plus 2, assemble one MK 6 Mod 4/5 and three MK 6 Mod 6 training weapons from ready status to CAS configuration.
- (b) Walkthrough procedures will be utilized throughout this period for maximum individual training.
- (c) Weapons will remain in the plant throughout this training period.

(2) Assembly Division II.

- (a) Between 1300Z and 2200Z on X day, X plus 1 and X plus 2, assemble two MK 17 Mod 1 training weapons from stockpile to CAS configuration.
- (b) Walkthrough procedures will be utilized throughout this period for maximum individual training.
- (c) Weapons will remain in the plant throughout this training period.

(3) Handling Division.

- (a) At 1300Z on X day accomplish breakout of one MK 6 Mod 4/5, three MK 6 Mod 6, and two MK 17 Mod 1 training weapons and deliver to respective plants for assembly training.
- (b) At 1300Z on X plus 3 remove one MK 6 Mod 4/5, three MK 6 Mod 6, and two MK 17 Mod 1 training weapons from the respective plants. These weapons will be utilized by the Handling Division for training purposes until 2200Z on X plus 4.
- (c) Weapons convoys to the WCP will be initiated at the discretion of the Handling Division Supervisor during the period 1300Z to 2200Z on X plus 3 and 1300Z to 1700Z on X plus 4.
- (d) During this training exercise only, the Handling Division will coordinate directly with Security for the necessary convoy and route security.

All Training weapons will be returned to storage by 2200Z on X plus 4.

(4) Nuclear Division.

- (a) On X plus 3 accomplish walkthrough operations to simulate EWP requirements as necessary. Maximum individual training to include:
1. Preparation of nuclear components (receiving).
  2. Initiation of convoy for component delivery to the WCP. For this training exercise only, coordinate directly with Security and deliver components at the discretion of the Nuclear Division Supervisor.
  3. Proper handling of paper work upon arrival at the WCP.

(5) Property Division.

- (a) Furnish required operational support for both assembly divisions during this training exercise.
- (b) Accomplish maximum individual training in support functions whether or not such functions are actually required by the assembly divisions.

(6) Operations Division.

- (a) On X plus 3 supply an Operations Center Controller at the WCP to coordinate procedures between the SAC controller, AMC-WCP Controller and the Stony Brook Operations Control Center.
- (b) On X plus 4 accomplish Operations Control Center functions applicable to a typical EWP operation to include:
1. Review, step by step, a typical special weapons operation.
  2. Accomplish on-the-spot corrections and improvements of functions not presently meeting required standards.
  3. Accomplish maximum individual training in the functions and operation of the Operations Control Center.

c. 3084th Security Squadron.

- (1) Between 1300Z and 1300Z on X plus 3 and 1300Z and 1700Z on X plus 4 accomplish necessary coordination with Westover AFE to provide convoy and route security to the WCP and return.
- (2) Conduct convoys when requested by the Handling and/or Nuclear Divisions.
- (3) Accomplish maximum individual training by walkthrough procedures.

d. 3084th Support Squadron

- (1) On X plus 3 SWASO will coordinate with the WCP in preparing necessary paperwork to simulate the accountability transfer.
- (2) Review, with SAC personnel at the WCP, the step by step transfer procedure required for weapon and component accountability.
- (3) Supply vehicle operators to the Nuclear Division on X plus 3 as requested.

X. General Instructions.

- (1) X day is 9 January 1956.
- (2) The duration of the exercise is from 1300Z to 2200Z X-day through X plus 4.
- (3) All MK 6 training weapons will be returned to ready status by 2200Z on X plus 2.
- (4) All MK 17 training weapons will be returned to stockpile status by 2200Z on X plus 2.
- (5) Production Control figures will not be reported to the Operations Control Center by the Assembly Divisions.
- (6) The Operations Control Center will not be operational during this exercise.
- (7) Nomenclature.
  - (a) Weapon and component designators will not be required for this operation.
- (8) Assembly and Handling Divisions will man 25 per cent of job positions with cross trained personnel.
