1. General Situation. This organization will support a joint AMC-SAC special weapons training exercise to be conducted during the period 13-17 February 1956. This order supports SAC-Ops O 19-56 and AMC Ops O 117-56, unclassified nickname is "Squeeze Play".

a. Enemy Forces: Omitted.

b. Friendly Forces:

- (1) 4050th Air Base Group (SAC) WAFB will implement the responsibilities outlined in Tab #2 to Appendix 7 to Annex C, WFF OPlan 44-56 dated 1 Nov 55 as are necessary to support this exercise.
- (2) 4050th Air Base Group (SAC), WAFB will also provide one C-45 aircraft with pilot, crew and security guards on standby alert for purpose of airlifting Nuclear Weapons Appraisal Officer to scenes of crash or emergencies.

2. Mission. The 3084th ADG will participate in an exercise paralleling portions of AMC and SAC EWPs constituting special weapons support of SAC aircraft of the 72nd Bomb Wing (H).

a. Broken out of storage

b. Assembled to CAS configuration

c. Dispersed

d. Convoyed to the WCP

e. Transferred to SAC with necessary records and documents for practice loading.

- f. Convoys to Stony Brook dispersal area after loading.

3. Tasks for Subordinate Units:

a. 3084th Operations Squadron: Provide an officer to act as convoy expediter to insure that convoys depart WCP as soon as possible after delivery of weapons. This officer will also insure that weapons are picked up for return to SBAFS as soon as possible after arrival at WCP.

(1) Assembly Division I:

- (a) Commencing at 1500Z X-day provide ten cross-trained personnel to Assembly Division II for repack of Type II training units utilized in this operation.

- (d) Inform operations control center of assembly times and other pertinent information relating to progress control log.

- (e) Furnish one technically qualified officer to inspect MK 17 MOD 1 training weapon before site 39D receipts for it from 4050th 39D Officer.

(3) Handling Division:

- (a) Prior to 1700Z X minus 1 procure from 4050th Munitions Branch (SAC) one MK 17 MOD 1 training weapon and deliver to igloo storage.

(b) Commencing at 1300Z X-Day, breakout

(1) Three MK 17 training weapons for delivery to Assembly Division II.

(c) Upon completion of assembly, weapons will be placed in dispersal for subsequent delivery to WCP or reassembly.

(d) Upon completion of first assembly, three MK 17 training units will be re-cycled through dispersal to Assembly Division II for repack and further assembly. Upon completion of second assembly, training weapons will be placed in dispersal for subsequent delivery to WCP.

(e) Commencing at 0300Z X-day plus 1 plan and initiate convoys of the above weapons to meet delivery schedules as noted in Annex A.

(f) One Straddle Carrier and driver will be made available to AMC Controller at the WCP for movement of weapons between WCP ramp and loading hardstands in accordance with Annex A.

(g) Initiate and coordinate formation of convoys conforming with Annex A to include notification of Security Squadron and Nuclear Division.

(h) Notify Operations Control Center of any anticipated delays that affect delivery of weapons and components to WCP as scheduled in Annex A.

(c) Provide a Nuclear Officer on standby alert at the WCP during all loading and unloading operations.

(d) Provide on standby alert at Base Operations a Nuclear Weapons Appraisal Officer with necessary equipment for transportation to scenes of accidents or emergencies.

(5) Operations Division:

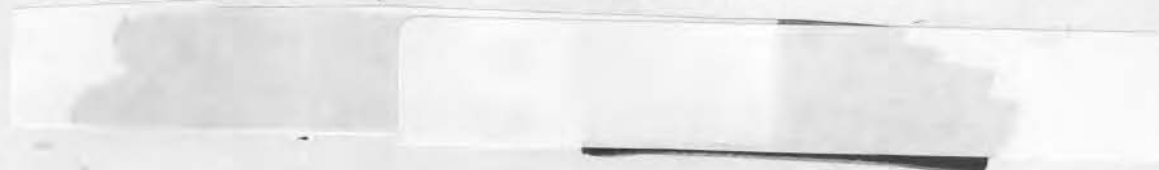
- (a) Activate Operations Control Center at 1300Z X-day for the duration of this exercise.
- (b) Keep applicable agencies posted on information necessary for this operation, as noted in Annex A, and any additional information supplied by WCP AMC Controller.
- (c) Maintain progress control log of significant events of this exercise.

b. 3084th Security Squadron:

- (1) Commencing at 0300Z X-day plus 1 provide security for and conduct convoys to the WCP as requested by Handling and Nuclear Divisions in accordance with Annex A.
- (2) Notify the Operations Control Center of times convoys depart Q gate, arrive at WCP and return Q area.
- (3) Effect necessary liaison with WAFB Security forces to provide route and area security on WAFB, in accordance with WAFB/SBAFS Agreement.

c. 3084th Support Squadron:

- (1) Commencing at 0330Z X-day plus 1 simulate war reserve accountability transfer procedures at the WCP, in accordance with Section V, Vol VII, para 2, AFM 67-1. Sufficient simulated documents should be prepared in advance of the transfer of weapons and capsules.
- (2) Extend messing facilities to cover the extended working hours on X-Day plus one.



- (3) Supply augmentation personnel to Nuclear and Handling Divisions as required.
- (4) Procure MK 17 W-1 training weapon from 4050th AEG 39D Supply Officer for use in this operation.

d. 3084th Inspection Sections:

- (1) Commencing at 0300Z X-Day plus one furnish weapons control point officers for the duration of the exercise.

x. General Instructions:

- (1) X-Day is 14 February 1956.
- (2) Operation will extend until approximately 0430Z X-Day plus two.
- (3) Convoys will be in accordance with Annex A.

- (6) Quantity distance criteria as established by Tables II and III Air Force Regulation 36-6 and safety practices will be observed throughout this exercise.

- (7) EMI procedures outlined in Station Manual 82-1 apply.

4. Administrative and Logistical Matters:

- a. WR weapons and components will be returned to the AEG Custodian upon completion of this exercise.
- b. As noted in 3084th Ops Plan 8-56.
- c. AEG Custodian or his assistant will monitor the use of War Reserve weapons.


