

SECURITY SQUADRON MISSION

The mission of the 3084th Security Squadron is to provide for the internal security of the 3084th Aviation Depot Group (AMG) Stony Brook Air Force Station, Chicopee Falls, Massachusetts.

The major factors which determine the overall mission of the Security Squadron are the mission of the 3084th Aviation Depot Group, and security standards established by higher headquarters, the Atomic Energy Commission, and local conditions.

ORGANIZATION

The internal security of Stony Brook Air Force Station, as provided by the Security Squadron, is categorized in three basic subdivisions:

a. Physical Security which includes:

(1) Operation of a guard force to control personnel access to controlled, limited, and exclusion areas, and to furnish an immediate tactical group of armed Air Police to investigate and combat any overt hostile acts against this Station.

(2) Provide Air Police well trained in ground combat as a nucleus for a Station defense organization in accordance with AFR 355-4.

b. Personnel Security which includes:

(1) Indoctrination of Station personnel in security procedures and precautions.

(2) Process personnel security clearances on, and supervise the degree of access to, classified material afforded personnel assigned to or employed on this Station.

(3) To establish a badge identification control system for all personnel on this Station.

(4) To conduct registration and supervise the storage of privately owned weapons on this Station.

(5) Maintenance and operation of Station Photographic Laboratory.

c. Law Enforcement which includes:

(1) Survey of vehicular traffic requirements within the confines of this Station.

(2) Development of traffic control facilities such as the establishment of speed limits, one-way roads, and positioning of traffic control signs.

(3) The enforcement of law and order on this Station.

(4) Maintenance of liaison with outside law enforcement agencies.

On staff level, it is the responsibility of the Director of Security to:

a. Interpret and establish procedures for the handling, storage, and safeguarding of all classified material on this Station.

b. Coordinate an external defense plan and establish and maintain an internal defense plan for this Station to include a comprehensive personnel training program.

c. Keep the 3084th Aviation Depot Group Commander informed of the general security situation, making recommendations for improvement where required.
